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#### LOW PARENT INVOLVEMENT



**Turn your snowy yard into a canvas** and paint the snow with water and food coloring. **Tip:** Water blasters are great for this.



Give your toys a bath

with old toothbrushes and soap. (Use cars, plastic animals, etc.)



**Take a bath with glow sticks** and turn out the lights. Party time!



Turn a paper bag into a wig for your stuffies! Cut vertical lines all around the circumference of the bag opening, place it on a stuffie's head and then give them a haircut!



**Go on an alphabet scavenger hunt** through your house. Find something that starts with each letter.



**Turn empty tissue boxes into robot shoes.**Don't forget to decorate them!



Play the floor is lava!

Make an obstacle course with laundry hampers, couch cushions, throw pillows, boxes, and whatever else you can find.

Make sure not to touch the floor!



Make shadow puppets

with construction paper. Shine a flashlight on the wall in a dark room and put on a show.



Collages are tons of fun!

Rip up magazines, junk mail, then add stickers and glue them down with glue sticks.



Draw a picture with your feet!



Decorate with paper snowflakes!

Cut out snowflakes from paper, decorate them with stickers, markers, or crayons, then hang them up in a window.



Draw a thank you card

for someone who recently did something kind for you.



Pretend your couch is a ship!

Use a pot lid for the ship's wheel, save your stuffies from drowning by tossing a lifesaver (throw pillow) for them to grab onto, use an empty toilet paper roll as a telescope, visit deserted islands, or find treasure!



Draw a picture

of you and someone you love who lives far away. Pop it in an envelope and mail it to them!



Build a couch fort

and bring some flashlights or glow sticks inside.



Pretend your couch is an airplane!

Pack your bags, give the pilot your ticket, buckle your seatbelt, eat snacks, and pretend you're traveling to a far away place.



Create ramps and hills for toy cars using couch cushions.



Start an air band!

Get pots and pans for the drums, a hairbrush for a microphone, turn up the music and perform your favorite song.



Make sculptures with mini-marshmallows and toothpicks!



**String o-shaped cereal bracelets** or necklaces on yarn. It's great for fine motor skills and doubles as a snack!





### outdoor play

#### Make an outdoor obstacle course!

Use found items (pylons, hula hoops, sports balls, shoes, blue bins) then run, jump, hula, or skip your way through.



#### Play winter golf!

Dig a hole in the snow, add a makeshift flag and hit a brightly colored ball with a hockey stick or toy golf club.



On a winter day, have a snow picnic! Go out in full snowsuits, lay out a blanket and enjoy a snack al fresco.

outdoor play

Make a giant tic-tac-toe!

Use sticks, rocks, snowballs, leaves, etc.



Bring in some plastic dishes and cups and host a bath time tea party for some waterproof animals or dolls. Bubbles, anyone?



When the bathroom is all steamed up from a shower, draw something on the foggy mirror with your finger.



Make a sock puppet out of one of those socks that's missing its mate!



Cut shapes in foam sheets from the craft store to make bath toys! They stick to the walls and make great storytelling prompts.



Make boats out of corks for bathtime!

Use elastic bands to hold two corks together, then decorate your boat with a toothpick flag.



Turn paper tubes into a set of binoculars and go on a nature walk to spot birds.



#### Make a fitted sheet balloon fort!

If you throw a fitted sheet in the air above a big bed, it'll catch the air and make a dome shape that's super fun to be under.



#### Make a road for toy cars

with painter's tape on the floor! Turn it into a town with boxes for buildings and figurines for people.



#### Host an art show

Tape up your drawings and paintings on the wall with painter's tape and invite your friends and family to join in-person or virtually. Don't forget some fancy snacks!



Grab some beach towels, sunglasses, and a fruity snack and lay them out in your family room to pretend you're spending a relaxing day at the beach. Take a dip but watch out for sharks!



#### Pretend your couch is a farm!

Stick toy veggies and fruits in the couch cracks and tend to your garden with a watering can and toy shovel. Harvest your veggies and sell them at your farmers market! Also works great with tovs or DIY flowers.



#### What's on my butt?

Get a partner and have them lie face down on the couch. Balance something on their butt and they have to try and guess what it is!



You've heard of tea parties with stuffies,

how about a stuffie dance party? Grab your favorite stuffies, put on your favorite song and create a mini dance party for them!



#### Toy car back massage:

Have your partner lie face down on the couch or floor, then drive toy cars all over their back for an enjoyable back scratch!



#### Guess the song!

Have someone play or hum the first three seconds of a song and see if you can guess what it is.



#### Build a clementine snowpal

using cloves and toothpicks! Use toothpicks to stick two clementines together and also for the arms. Then use cloves for the face and buttons.



#### HIGH PARENT INVOLVEMENT



#### Go on a neighborhood scavenger hunt!

Find a snowpal (real or fake), the number two, something yellow, a triangle, something noisy, something cozy, and something HUGE.



#### Make colored ice cubes with

food coloring, then take them outside to make cheerful 3D sculptures in your yard!



#### Turn a cardboard box into a TV set!

Act out your favorite shows, the news, the weather, photo slideshows, etc. Have someone pretend to change the channels and watch the show!



#### Have a picnic inside!

Set up a blanket and have lunch on the floor.



#### Play a game of stuffed animal hide and seek.

Take turns hiding a favorite stuffie and then go on a search to find it.



#### Play a game of I Spy

in the illustrations of your kiddo's favorite book.



#### Go on an indoor scavenger hunt!

Take turns going on a hunt for household items. For example, find five things that are red, four things that are soft, three things that are square, etc. Get creative with some silly suggestions!



#### Make some surrealist art together!

Fold paper into three parts, and take turns creating a body, drawing one section at a time and folding your portion so it's hidden from the next person. When everyone's done, open it up to reveal a fantastical character!



#### Play the doodle game!

One person starts by drawing a squiggly line, then take turns magically transforming it into something unexpected.



Grab a partner and take turns teaching

an art class! Show each other how to draw your favorite thing.



Throw a birthday party for one of your kiddo's stuffies. Get creative with some DIY decorations, grab some snacks, and be sure to invite other stuffies and toys to join the party!



#### Pretend you're staying at a luxurious hotel.

Get super cozy in bed and take turns delivering room service, with snacks and other surprises.



Put on a blindfold and do taste tests

of different things in your fridge.



#### Make some fruit or veggie kabobs!

Put pre-cut pieces of fruit on wooden skewers to create a colorful snack. (Maybe throw in a marshmallow or two just for fun!)



Play a game of video chat charades!

Have relatives and friends guess what you're acting out over a video call.



#### Play a game of freeze dance!

Get dancing to your favorite song, and then see if you can freeze in place when your partner pauses the song.



#### Play hide and seek over a video call

with relatives and friends. Have one person hide the device somewhere in the house (kitchen cupboard, closet, under the couch cushions). The person on the video call makes noises until they're found!



#### Try a video call guessing game!

One person holds the camera reeeeeallly close to an object and slowly backs up. The person on the other end has to quickly guess what it is before they zoom out to reveal the whole thing! (Think lego blocks, plants, fruit, crayons, etc.)



Host a virtual video call dance party

with your friends! Ask for their favorite dance songs ahead of time, make a playlist, schedule a meeting, and ask friends to bring glow sticks, disco lights, and dance party vibes. Tip: A grown-up should DJ on a separate device. Don't forget to click "share sound!"
